2026-2027 Policies & Procedures

Welcome to Dance Institute for the **2026-2027** Dance year! We are so happy to have you! Please take time to read and understand our studio policies and procedures. We request that you keep all emails throughout the school year, as you receive them from Dance Institute. Please ensure the email on your Parent Portal is up to date. We will use this email for all communications regarding the 2026-2027 season. Please ensure your account is set up to "send emails to family". If you click "opt-out" then there will be no way for us to communicate to you regarding any Dance Institute information for 2026-2027.

If any parent/student wishes for a private conference concerning personal dance goals or financial concerns, please do not hesitate to ask. We are happy to work with you to ensure that your school year will be filled with joy and personal growth. The entire faculty and staff wish you a fantastic year of dance!

Withdraw/ Cancel policy:

To terminate enrollment, prior to August 24th, **2026**, a withdrawal form is needed to be turned in by the 15th of the month. Reach out to info@danceinstitute.com for a withdrawal form.

You must sign and turn in a Dance Institute cancel form BEFORE the 15th of the month in order to take effect for the following month. Monthly tuition will continue until the office receives a signed DI **WITHDRAWAL** form. *(Example: a cancellation form received between April 1st and April 15th will terminate your tuition effective May 1st)* If the form is received after the 15th of the month, you will be responsible for full tuition for the following month.

If a dancer withdraws, and then re-enrolls at anytime within a season, there will be a \$50 registration fee. **NO STUDENT MAY CANCEL AND RE-ENROLL WITHOUT FULL REPAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEE.** This includes withdrawing for the summer and enrolling for the following fall/spring.

Adding/ Dropping Classes:

Anytime a class is added or dropped, a parent **MUST** fill out an ADD/Drop Class Form. **This must be done by the 15th of the month, to make necessary changes to your tuition for the upcoming month.** If the form is received after the 15th of the month, you will be responsible for the tuition of the dropped class for the following month.

Payment & Tuition

Enrollment is from August 24th, 2026-May 31st, 2027, and is an ANNUAL tuition based on the number of dance hours per week. Monthly payments will be made in 12 equal installments. Tuition will be charged to your credit card on the **1st OF THE MONTH**. If the card on file is **declined, an additional charge of \$10 will be added to your account.** If payment is not received before the 5th of the month a \$15 late fee will be assessed. This late fee will increase by \$10 every 10 days until tuition has been paid. Tuition is non-transferable for missed classes including holidays or vacations. Your dancer can reach out to the office to schedule makeup class within that same month.

*Primrose only classes: All Primrose clients have an additional \$10.00/mo. fee for transportation.

Spring Show & Costume Fees:

Each dancer will have a Spring show fee (sibling discount applies). Spring show fee includes 2 complimentary tickets **per dancer**. You will receive an email using the email on your Parent Portal account with information regarding how to claim your complimentary tickets. This email will be sent out in March from Dance Recital Ticketing. A Spring Show Packet will be provided at the start of February 2027. If a dancer cancels enrollment the 2 complimentary tickets will be forfeited. Each dancer will also receive a Spring Show T-Shirt and digital download of the performance. The **Spring show performance fee of \$130/dancer** is applied toward the rental of the auditorium, staff, sets, etc. Please avoid conflicts and make recital your number one priority that day. Spring show, tech, & dress rehearsal is an all day event for instructors and students. If you have more than one child dancing, or are in multiple classes, plan on your child being in multiple shows. We will hold a studio-wide dress rehearsal & tech rehearsal for classes performing in spring show at the theatre. A dancer who registers **after Dec 31st** will not be able to participate in Spring Show.

Spring Show Costume fees/details:

Sparks Class costumes: \$75 (includes tights if applicable)

All level Academy Class costumes: \$85 (includes tights if applicable)

A non- refundable costume deposit (half of the costume fee per recital class your dancer is registered for) will be charged at the same time as the spring show performance fee. Costume balances will be emailed out and a late fee of 15% (of your total costume amount) will be applied if paid after due date.

Costumes cannot be returned or refunded once ordered. If your dancer is unable to participate in Spring Show the office needs to know before December 19th, 2026.

Student of the Month:

Student of the month is based on the following criteria:

Attendance - should be perfect to be considered.

Attire & Grooming- wearing the appropriate dance attire or uniform and hair must be pulled back in ponytail/bun (refer to DI dress code).

Attention in class, retention and **behavior** is also considered when determining student of the month.

The student that has received the most "Student of the Month" certificates throughout the year will be in the running for student of the year. The student of the year will be announced at Spring Show.

There is a student of the year for each age group and one overall.

The dancer that wins in their age group will receive one month's free tuition the following season.

The dancer that wins overall, will receive an 100% tuition scholarship the following season!

In case of bad weather:

In the case of bad weather, Dance Institute follows Leander ISD for all weather situations. If there should be a question as to whether or not class will be held, you can check our website or social media for more information.

****Additional Studio Policies****

1. Arrive to class on time- Based on instructors discretion, a late student, may not be permitted to take class, yet will be expected to observe.
2. For safety reasons we ask that your child use the restroom before class begins. Students may not leave class without their teacher's permission.
3. Act respectfully and appropriate. Bullying, disrespect to others, or foul language will not be tolerated.
4. Students should carry all belongings into the studio with them. DI is not responsible for any personal items left in studios or lobbies. If any belongings are found left behind, they will go to our lost and found, which is donated to Goodwill at the end of each semester.
5. Food & gum are not allowed in the studios. Water and beverages should be in containers with screw tops. Please clean up after yourself and help us keep Dance Institute clean.
6. Our lobby/waiting areas are closed to parents. Once class has started
7. Children under the age of 8 should not be left unattended in waiting areas before class starts.
8. Dance class is educational and fun, however, an important part of class work is developing an attitude of discipline and respect for others. We trust that following our classroom etiquette will provide an environment whereby classes at **Dance institute** will be a pleasure for all concerned.
